Rep. of the Congo). The Assumption oversees a quality secondary education too, at Bishop Michel Canonne High School in EJeDa.</p> <p>By means of these educational endeavors, the Assumptionists seek to remain close to the local population and to offer this forgotten people a means of development through education, never losing sight of the congregation's desire to witness its faith by serving the neediest.</p> <p><b>Being sought:</b></p> <p>Volunteer teachers and educators who can form primary and secondary teachers.</p> <p><u>Further information:</u> Fr. It aims at fostering dialogue between Eastern and Western Christians, in particular between Catholics and Orthodox.</p> <p>The Center's activities are basically threefold :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- a large library (20,000 volumes) specializing in the Christian East;</li> <li>- sponsorship of a wide range of public ecumenical conferences and seminars;</li> <li>- a residence for 12 young men, Catholic and Orthodox.</li> </ul> <p><b>Being sought:</b></p> <p>Volunteers willing to oversee the Internet site, edit conference papers, oversee the restoration of the library's ancient volumes, and to complete the indexing of works in foreign languages (Greek, Russian, etc.).</p> <p><u>Further information :</u> Fr. These people have a hard time undertaking the steps necessary to get out of their situations. They are unaware of their rights and duties. They simply don't know how to go about things. «Accompagner» places at their service 40 volunteers, people ready to accompany them and help them to undertake administrative steps to get back on their feet.</p> <p>What do we seek to do?
