**THE ESSENTIAL
Father Benoît Grière reelected as
Superior General**



A solemn moment this Tuesday morning with the election of the person who will guide the congregation during the next six years. Father Benoit Griere, superior General and, consequently, the president of the Chapter was in charge of the animation of this time of the election.

Before the election there was a prayer during which a hymn was sung calling on the Holy Spirit to come over the chapter members and over the person who will be elected to become the 10th successor to Father d'Alzon at the head of the congregation.



The passage of the Gospel of Saint Marc (10:32-45) that insists on service was proclaimed in the three official languages of the congregation. After that the chapter members cast their vote by writing the name of the person who they think is best suited for being the superior General.

Thus Father Benoit Griere was reelected as the superior General. Father Richard Lamoureux then asked Father Benoit if he accepted the call of the 33rd General Chapter of the congregation.

General accepts the responsibility for the service of the whole body. The Assumption rejoices. We have a general, now let's give him a plan to enact and a team to work with him. So right away it's back to work!”

THE ESSENTIAL: On the way to the future, with audacity



A theme around the Charism emerges, that of unity. A horizon mobilizes: reform and build an Assumptionist future, under the sign of the new wine.

The exercise is not obvious: that of projecting itself for the years to come. It has to take into account the common good; beyond known circles, and avoiding resorting to the recipes of yesteryear. The Chapter leans to exercise in all fields. It swings from the government of the Congregation to its financial and economic life.

First, on Wednesday, the Assembly took the time to mark the event of the previous day: the re-election of the superior general, Fr. Benoît Grière.

Here is the statement he made at the beginning of the work: "I would like to express my appreciation for the renewed confidence you have shown in entrusting me with a new mandate of 6 years. I am well aware that I am not a brother without shortcomings or defects. I give myself up to the grace of God so that He may make me a good instrument of his will in the service of the congregation and of the Church. But once the choice has been made, we must move forward together to meet the major challenges ahead. You know that I like St. Augustine's reflection: "It is better for a lame man on the road than a runner out of the way." The lame, it is I, it is we, it is the man who recognizes himself sinner and limited. He advances cahin-caha, but he's on the way. And we know, the way, the truth, the life, it is Jesus Christ. The road we have to take together is the Gospel, good news for today. We have no other way to look for than this one. The path, like that of Emmaus, is an itinerary that one frequents with several. I know that it is with brothers, religious and lay people that I will continue to advance
