## **1. Migrant Ministry in El Paso, TX**

*Your donation will go directly to our new foundation at St. Francis Xavier Parish in El Paso, TX, and will support initiatives to meet the spiritual and material needs of migrants and aid in the continued establishment of our presence at the U.S./Mexico border.*

### **2. Education in Beni, Democratic Republic of the Congo**

*Your donation will support the Assumptionist-run Prince of Peace School, which currently serves 683 students, many of whom have been personally affected by the violence in the Beni region. Donations allow for continued scholarships for needy children and construction of additional classrooms.*

### **3. Education in Nairobi, Kenya**
