

On Monday, October 18th, the National Catholic Development Conference (NCDC) in collaboration with the United States Region of the Assumptionists and Assumption College hosted a workshop "What is Happening in Catholic Fundraising Today" on the Campus of Assumption College in Worcester, MA.
