



In the presence of the Mayor, Jorge Venegas, regional and Church authorities, the new gymnasium of Manuel d'Alzon High School in Lota was official inaugurated.

It was in the context of the Bicentennial projected adopted in 2010 to improve the institution's infrastructure that it was decided to foresee a gymnasium that could house a variety of sporting, recreational and cultural activities. The project also included the construction of Learning Resources Center, the construction and organization of a language and mathematics laboratory, and the equipping of classrooms with digital blackboards and multimedia projectors.
