



At the close of the Jubilee Year of 2000, in reference to the Christian's call to HOLINESS by virtue of Baptism, St. John Paul II writes the following: "The time has come to repropose wholeheartedly to everyone this *high standard of ordinary Christian living*" (Apostolic Letter: *No vo Millenio Ineunte*, #31).
