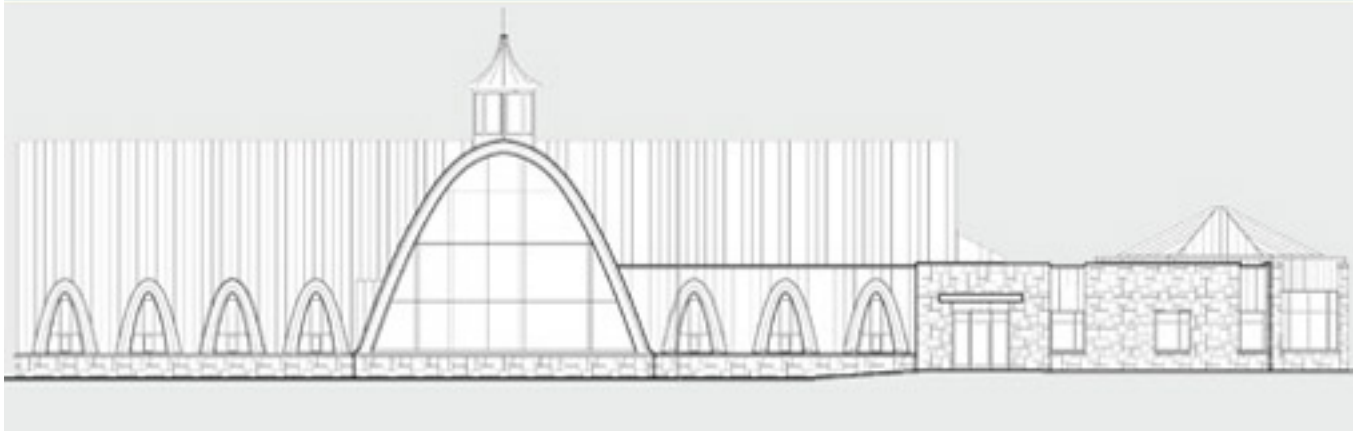

Campus Ministry plays a vital role in the pastoral, liturgical, academic and social life of Assumption College. The Campus Ministry staff is committed to the development and transformation of our students through many programs; and yet, as with the faithful in the Old Testament, they have wandered in search of a permanent home since a fire destroyed the original center in 1993.

The building of a new Campus Ministry Center has been a long time coming. After 17 years of discussions and planning, the Center was officially incorporated into the College's strategic plan in 2008. The Board of Trustees approved the project last year when Institutional Advancement reported it had gifts and commitments of \$3.3 million toward the \$3.9 million project. Site work took place in the summer of 2010. Although the official breaking is not scheduled till April, the campus ministry team moved into their new facilities last week.
